Fall 2020

2 courts of play (4 players/team) for each duel ladies & men's matches – 6-12 players on team roster
At least 6 regular season matches for all teams plus playoffs (for teams that qualify)

- June 1 – July 20, 2020 – Fall registration open
- August 17, 2020 – Play begins this week
- September 7, 2020 – No play on Labor Day
- October 6-12, 2020 – Semi-Final matches in divisions with 6 or more teams.
- October 14, 2020 – Wednesday - Fall League Finals at Plaza and nearby clubs

New! Roster Ratings will now be used for Rules, pairings and court assignments, (not current ratings).

Roster eligibility is a wider range than the range for play. Range for play is noted parenthetically in the division name. Wider roster availability allows more players to be eligible for a team, although players above or below the range for play need to be paired with higher or lower partner to keep the pairing compatible with the division and to follow pairing rules. In 'A' divisions roster eligibility is 4 below/1 above low/high numbers in division range for play. For 'B' divisions it is 1 below/4 above. For divisions without an A or B in the division name it is 4 below/4 above.
