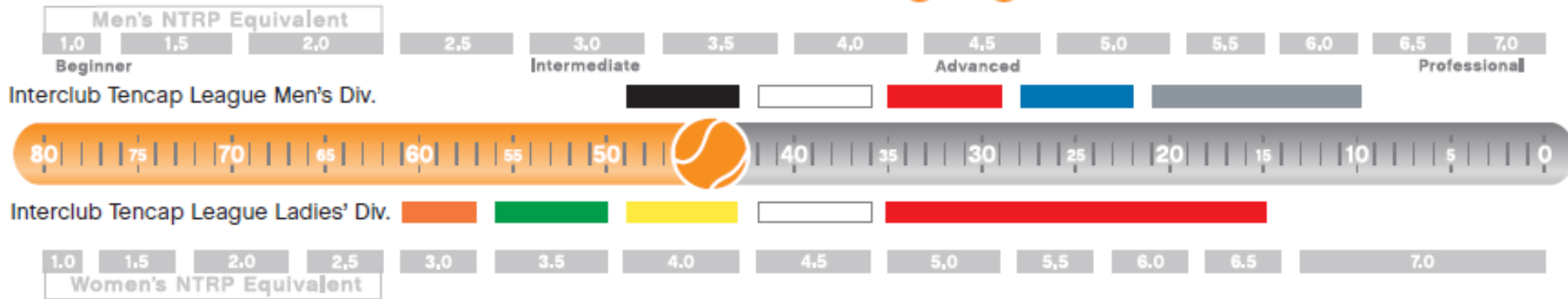

League Divisions - Range for Play and how it relates to Pairings and range for Roster Eligibility

The Range for Play is located parenthetically in the name of each division.

- **Pairings for Play**
 - Low - No pairing (using Roster Ratings) may be lower than .5 below the low number in the Range for Play. All divisions.
 - High – Pairings may not be higher (using Roster Ratings) than .5 above the high number in the Range for Play for A divisions or not be higher than 2 above the range for play in B divisions. Divisions with no A or B in the name, no higher than 2 above.
- **Roster eligibility** – this is wider than the range for play; allowing for a wider range of people to be eligible for a team. However, pairings for play must more narrowly conform to the Range for Play.
 - Divisions with no A or B in division name – 4 below to 4 above Range for Play
 - A divisions – 4 below to 1 above the Range for Play
 - B divisions – 1 below to 4 above the Range for Play
